## Guide for Interpreting Course Evaluation Reports

The green numbers indicate the scale that students see when filling out the evaluation. They are added here for clarity.

Positive numbers indicate students agree with the statement and negative numbers indicate they disagree with the statement.

The report indicates the average for each section and the overall average.
